CHISHOLM VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT FACILITY

Discussion took place on the present condition of the Fire Department Facility. Council member Todd Scaia informed the council that the "Scope of Work" prepared by Senior Engineer, Steve Ekman with AMI Engineers for the repair of the Fire Hall concrete floor will be discussed at the August 11, 2016 council meeting. The Chisholm City Council is looking at options for a place to house its fire hall.

The following options were reviewed at the working session:

- 1) Building a new multi-department structure near the castle at the city's east entrance.
- 2) The possibility of purchasing and repurposing the former Minnesota Power Building in the Industrial Park.

Council members requested that the current City Hall building be considered as a possible location. Architectural Resources of Hibbing, MN compiled a "Prior Use Plan" for City Hall and the Public Safety facility. City Administrator John Tourville was directed to research previous plans for that option.
