**PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED AMENDED ASSESSMENT FOR
CENTER DRIVE**

FEBRUARY 25, 2015

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Michael A. Jugovich called the public hearing to order at 5:00 pm in the City Hall Council Chambers.

PUBLIC HEARING

The council opened the Public Hearing to address any questions from Center Drive area residents that were in attendance.

Jim Johnson, Consulting Engineer then presented a summary for the amended assessment of the Center Drive project. This included a review of construction costs, total costs and a breakdown of the project costs. The proposed negotiated assessment rate is \$20.00 per the benefited front frontage of 2,367.50 plus direct costs of \$6,234.03. The total amount assessed to the residents is \$53,584.03 of the total proposed project cost of \$931,197.14.

Councilor Todd Scaia questioned the plans for planting grass in an area discussed previously. Jim Johnson responded that the Contractor's warranty for this project will run through October 2015 and a final walk through will take place in September of 2015. The previous request of one of the residents to have an apron put in was addressed and Councilor Todd Scaia asked if the City Garage staff could do this.
