PUBLIC HEARING ON 6<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE NE ALLEY IMPROVEMENT

PUBLIC HEARING

James Johnson, SEH, consulting engineer to the City of Chisholm gave an overview of the proposed reconstruction of the alley east of 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE, between East Lake Street and 1<sup>st</sup> Street NE. Patti Wood, a resident at 623 NE 1<sup>st</sup> Street, spoke in opposition to the project, as her driveway exits onto 1<sup>st</sup> Street NE, and the project would be of no benefit to her. Also noted were property owners at 600 East Lake Street and 601 1<sup>st</sup> Street NE who were opposed to a full assessment due to the fact that their driveways exit onto 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE, also not benefitting totally from the reconstruction; and would also be opposed to the project if consideration for a partial assessment is not taken into account.
