

**CHISHOLM CITY COUNCIL
RECONVENED MEETING – AUGUST 13, 2010
TO CANVASS VOTES OF PRIMARY ELECTION**

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Michael A. Jugovich reconvened the recessed meeting of August 11, 2010 in the City Hall Council Chambers at 9:00 am.

COIN TOSS TIE BREAKER

Candidates Frank Skalski and Brandan Fiedler, having both received 185 votes each in the Primary Election of August 10, 2010, required a tie breaker to further determine which candidate would move on to the general election. This would be settled by the toss of a coin. Prior to the coin toss, it was determined "Heads" for Mr. Fiedler, and "Tails" for Mr. Skalski. The coin was tossed by Administrator Casey, and "Heads" prevailed. This was attested to by Councilor Novoselac. Brandan Fiedler was then declared the 4th person moving on to the general election of November 2, 2010.
