

ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE VII: TRAFFIC CODE, CHAPTER 74
OF THE CITY CODE ENTITLED "PARKING SCHEDULES"

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHISHOLM DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS

WHEREAS, Chapter 74. Parking Schedules said Section shall be amended to read as follows:

Schedule

- I. Limited Parking
- II. Fourth Street Southwest and Third Avenue Southwest

SCHEDULE I. LIMITED PARKING.

(A) Unlawful acts.

- (1) It is unlawful to park a vehicle on the side of a street bearing even-numbered building numbers from 6:00 p.m. on every odd-numbered date to 6:00 p.m. on the day following, or on streets/avenues which have been duly sign-posted.
- (2) It is unlawful to park a vehicle on the side of a street bearing odd-numbered building numbers from 6:00 p.m. on every even-numbered date to 6:00 p.m. on the day following, or on streets which have been duly sign-posted.
- (3) Notwithstanding provisions of this section to the contrary, it is unlawful to:
 - (a) Park a vehicle on Lake Street between Central Avenue and Fourth Avenue West between the hours of 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m.
 - (b) Park a vehicle in such a way as to impede emergency vehicles, garbage trucks and/or City maintenance vehicles.

(B) Exceptions. Notwithstanding provisions of this section to the contrary:

- (1) Parking is permitted on both sides of the streets/avenues which are duly posted indicating their exemption from the general calendar parking rules;
- (2) Parking is permitted only on one side of the following streets/avenues:
 - (a) South side of Fifth Street South between Second Avenue West and Fourth Avenue West; (behind Senior High)
 - (b) South side of Nine and a Half Street between First Avenue North East to Fourth Avenue North East. (by Vaughan- Steffensrud)
 - (c) West side of First Avenue North East between Nine and a Half Street North and Eleventh Street North East. (by Vaughan-Steffensrud)
 - (d) South side of Fourth Street SW between 4th Avenue and 2nd Avenue SW.
- (3) Parking is permitted on both sides of First Avenue West between Second Street South and Sixth Street South between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon on Sundays only.

(C) Violating Vehicles/Removal

- (1) In addition to the receipt of a standard parking citation, vehicles violating Sections (A)(1) through (A)(3) above shall be subject to removal/tow and owners expense under the following circumstances:
 - a. At the time of an existing calendar parking violation there is three inches of freshly fallen and un-cleared snow.
 - b. A vehicle that has been unlawfully parked under this section is impeding the passage of an emergency vehicle, garbage truck, or City maintenance vehicle that is engaged in the performance of its intended purpose.

- c. A law enforcement officer observes an illegally parked vehicle that they have probable cause to believe has failed to respond to five or more parking or traffic citations.
- d. A vehicle is unlawfully parked in an area that had been posted at least 12 hours in advance as restricted parking.
- e. In addition to the specific basis for towing enumerated herein, a law enforcement officer shall also have the authority to tow or remove any vehicle as permitted by Minn. Stat. 168B.035 subd. 3b, the terms of which are hereby incorporated by reference as the same may be changed from time to time.

(2) Before a vehicle may be towed pursuant to this provision, a law enforcement officer must, in addition to issuing a citation for the violation, prepare a tow report that details the basis for the tow/removal of the vehicle.

All other provisions of Chisholm City Code Section 74 shall remain as currently in existence and not amended except as specifically identified herein and said amendment shall be effective immediately upon its passage.


