

CHISHOLM CEMETERY RULES

- 1) Artificial flowers, flower boxes, vases or other containers must be removed from the Cemetery no later than October 15th of each year. The City is not responsible for damage during the winter.
- 2) Only shrubbery of the Pyramidal Arboviate variety shall be permitted, subject to the approval of the Cemetery Sexton.
- 3) No shrubbery shall be allowed in the Veteran's section, on single or infant graves.
- 4) Only one (1) flower basket per family lot. The basket to be placed in front of the monument or the section that is reserved for the monument.
- 5) No metal, brick, wire, wood, cement, rock or plastic borders shall be permitted around flower beds, shrubbery or lots.
- 6) Any decoration, wire hanger or objects anchored to the ground with wire are not permitted. All Veteran, Moose, American Legion or other emblems must be placed by the monument or in the Area reserved for the monument.
- 7) Only one (1) headstone per family lot. Width of the headstone base not to exceed sixteen inches. Length of the base not to exceed six (6) feet. On the Northside of the Cemetery the width of the base is not to exceed fourteen (14) inches and the length not to exceed four (4) feet.
- 8) All grave decoration at family's own risk.
- 9) All granite markers to be set at grass level to preclude equipment damage.
- 10) Grave markers (footstones) double or single, may only be installed after interment has been made in the lot. Double flat markers when used as headstones are permissible.
- 11) The City of Chisholm has the right to enter or cross any lot to facilitate interment procedures.
- 12) The City of Chisholm will not be responsible for any damage to any existing trees, shrubbery, flower beds, flower baskets, vigil lamps or urns that interfere with digging or mowing operations.
- 13) It shall be the duty of the Sexton to enter upon any lot or grave to prohibit, modify, or remove and dispose of any structure or object which may have been placed there in violation of any of the rules and regulations submitted or which may be considered in his judgment to be unsightly, dangerous, or objectionable or interferes with Cemetery operations.
- 14) The Cemetery is open to the public from 7 A.M. to 9 P.M. daily.
- 15) No dogs are allowed in the Cemetery.
- 16) The City Council reserves the right to change these rules or to make such other rules as they deem necessary for the operation of the Cemetery. No notice of such intended changes shall be required.

GUIDELINES – PRE-NEED SECTIONS

- 1) The following sections will be the only pre-sale sections in the Chisholm Cemetery. Lots can be purchased in these sections before there is a death in the family. These sections are Block H-1, Block K-1 and Section 3, Block D (Northside).
- 2) Limit to pre-need sales to a maximum of 2 lots per person:
 1. husband
 2. wife
 3. head of household – including disabled dependent
- 3) Lots will also be sold as needed in these sections.
- 4) No sales until all prep work is completed, i.e. roads, leveling, measured and plotted.
- 5) Vaults and/or grave boxes will be required in these sections.
- 6) Lot size (to be sold as single lots) – 5' x 11'.
- 7) Residents rates apply only to the citizens of Chisholm.

- 8) An extra lot must be purchased if a family wishes to erect a mausoleum. For example, 2 lots for a single mausoleum and 3 lots for a double mausoleum.
