INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor John Champa called the public hearing to order at 4:30 p.m. at the Sr. Citizens Center to hear comments and concerns on the proposed infrastructure improvements to the 3rd Street NW Area.

PUBLIC HEARING

Jim Johnson, Consulting Engineer gave a presentation of the 3rd Street NW area infrastructure and improvements project. He went over the four different alternatives that were included in the feasibility study. The preferred option is #4 with construction costs of \$1.098 million and a total project cost of \$1.433 million. This option does not have a lift station, it is all gravity fed.

He discussed the need to obtain an easement from Mr. Novakovich. The residents will be polled as to whether or not they want sidewalks installed. For trees that are removed to complete the project, residents will be given the option to purchase trees that can be placed on their property. The City will reimburse them up to \$150.00 for the purchase.
