

ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY CODE SECTION 153.30

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2016 Governor Dayton signed a law creating and regulating temporary family health care dwellings, which law was codified at Minn. Stat. §462.3593 and not only permits such temporary dwellings, but compels cities to issue permits regardless of local planning and zoning requirements; and

WHEREAS, subdivision 9 of Minn. Stat. §462.3593 allows cities to “opt out” of the regulations of that section:

THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHISHOLM ORDAINS as follows:

Section 153.30 of the City Code is amended to include the following language:

153.30 (10) will read as follows:

(10) Opt-Out of Minnesota Statutes, Section 462.3953. Pursuant to the authority granted by Minnesota Statutes, Section 462.3593, subdivision 9, the City of Chisholm opts-out of the requirements of Minn. Stat. §462.3593, which defines and regulates Temporary Family Health Care Dwellings.

All other provisions of Chisholm City Code 153.30 shall remain as currently in existence and not amended except as specifically added herein and said amendment shall be effective immediately upon its passage.


