The City of Chisholm is seeking Election Judges to serve in and assist with preparation and execution of the 2024 elections process. Election Judges are essential to our democracy and provides the opportunity to learn the election process and serve your community.

In order to apply, you must be eligible to vote in Minnesota and able to read, write and speak English. Students 16 and 17 years-old can be election judge trainees. There are restrictions on having relatives serve together as election judges. A relative is defined as a spouse, parent, stepparent, child, stepchild, sibling, or stepsibling. Relatives cannot serve together in the same precinct at the same time. In addition, relatives of a candidate, and anyone who temporarily or permanently lives in the same house as a candidate, cannot serve in the precinct where the candidate is on the ballot. Candidates cannot serve in a precinct where they are on the ballot.

Election judges will be required to complete training sessions and work from 6:00 am to poll close on election days, half shifts may be available. Duties include signing in voters, register voters, distribute ballots, and ensure voters are permitted to vote, operate and/or assist with voting equipment, attention to detail and count accuracy, and delivery of excellent customer service. Pay for Election Judges will range from \$10.85 to 11.85 per hour.
