

**CHISHOLM CITY COUNCIL
PUBLIC HEARING – APRIL 12, 2011
ASSESSMENT OF 6TH AVE NE ALLEY RECONSTRUCTION**

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Michael A. Jugovich called the Public Hearing meeting to order at 5:00 pm in the City Hall Council Chambers.

PUBLIC HEARING

Jim Johnson of SEH gave a presentation and overview of the 6th Ave NE Alley Reconstruction project. Total cost will be \$46,468.81 plus overhead. The assessment is proposed over a ten year period at an interest rate of 5%. Marco Lubovich, a resident from the 6th Ave NE area felt the barricade that Bill Marco put up should have been torn down as Bill Marco's service line is underneath the barricade. In answer to Mr. Marco's question of whether a fire hydrant was installed, Jim Johnson's reply was no. Sink holes in the alley are a big concern of Mr. Lubovich. Administrator Casey mentioned that projects are and will continue to be coordinated with M P & L and other companies to eliminate digging holes after a project is completed. Mayor Jugovich thanked Mr. Lubovich for attending the Public Hearing.
