He is confident it will be a smooth transition. He said that it has been an honor to have the opportunity to serve along side not only the employees of this great town but also its citizens. Chief Manner expressed that it has been fun and a dream job to have. He plans to retire within the first quarter of the year by April 1st. It has not been an easy decision, but the timing is right. He thanked council for the hard work it took to build the public safety building and feels that there is a great team in place and he is very proud of that. Council expressed their gratitude for the work Chief Manners has done.
