The purpose of this meeting is to determine whether taxable property in the city has been properly valued and classified by the assessor, and also to determine whether corrections need to be made.

If you believe the value or classification of your property is incorrect, please contact your assessor's office to discuss your concerns. If you are still not satisfied with the valuation or classification after conferring with the assessor's office, you may appeal in person, by representative, or in writing to the local board of appeal and equalization. Written appeals must be received by the City of Chisholm City Administrator by 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, April 16th, 2024. Your written appeal may be mailed, emailed, or dropped off at Chisholm City Hall.
