

CHISHOLM CITY COUNCIL
PUBLIC ASSESSMENT HEARING

November 7, 2018, 7:00 P.M.

8th STREET NW AREA

Meeting convened at 7:00 p.m. with the following attendees: Consultant Engineer James Johnson, Interim Administrator David Carlstrom, Residents- Ronald Hultman, G. Dolinar, Karen Bevka, Mary Lee Nienas, and Robert Fritz.

Mr. Johnson reviewed the total project on 8th street, and explained the project was divided into two areas for assessment purposes. The part of the project west of 3rd Avenue, and the part east of 3rd Avenue. He explained the west part of the project received a total reconstruction and is projected to receive a full assessment, and the easterly portion which will receive a partial assessment based on the limited work to be completed there. The residents questioned the assessment being made before the project was totally completed. Mr. Johnson stated the City has already received loan monies for the project and will be making payments on those loans in 2019. The project is scheduled to be completed before the assessment payments are made by the residents. Other concerns mentioned: traffic control, leveling of the water flow line on the East portion of the project with the mill and overlay.

Mr. Johnson also reviewed the various methods for making payments on the assessment.

There being no further discussion, the hearing adjourned at 7:30 p.m.
