PUBLIC ASSESSMENT HEARING

LAKEVIEW ADDITION AREA INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

NOVEMBER 7, 2018 – 5:00 P.M.

The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. The following were in attendance: Mayor Mary Jo Rahja, Councilors Varda and Halverson, Consultant Engineer James Johnson, Interim Administrator David Carlstrom, City Clerk William Manney, Utilities Clerk Denise Kealy, Rick Kotula, Steve Bartek, Bob Studinski, Claudette Oberstar, Ron Simonson, Rick Paine, Margaret Gornick.

Mr. Johnson summarized the project area included in the assessment area, and also the projected total project cost of completion in the Spring of 2019. The residents questioned the assessment being made before the total completion of the project. Mr. Johnson stated the City has already received loans for the project and will be making payments in 2019 on those loans, which will require assessments to be received. He additionally stated that the project is planned to be completed before the first payment by the residents are made. Other discussions included: traffic flow, damage sidewalks, valve height and project completion check-list. Mr. Johnson asked the people present to note any concerns/problems they have regarding the project, and forward them to him so they can be included in the final check-list.

Mr. Johnson also reviewed the various methods for making payments on the assessment.
