

ORDINANCE NO. 4, 3rd SERIES

ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY CODE SECTION 153.04 AND 153.05

CHISHOLM CITY CODE 153.04 IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS BY ADDING THE FOLLOWING:

Firewood: Any wood or wood product used or intended to be used in a fire pit, fireplace, or used as heating fuel in the City of Chisholm. Painted or treated wood shall not be burned in a fire pit, fireplace, or used as heating fuel.

CHISHOLM CITY CODE 153.05 IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS BY ADDING THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS:

153.05 (A)(1) will read as follows:

- (A) Exterior Storage.
- (1) In R Residential Districts, all materials and equipment shall be stored within a building except materials currently being used on the premises, firewood, and agricultural equipment and materials if these are used or intended for use on the premises, off-street parking of passenger automobiles and children's play equipment.

153.05 (A)(3) will read as follows:

- (A) Exterior Storage.
- (3) Firewood may be stored upon a residential premises, not for resale. Cordwood (logs) shall not be stored on any boulevard, short or long term, or upon any residential premises.

153.05 (C)(4) will read as follows:

- C) Screening.
- (4) In all districts, all exterior storage, materials, and/or firewood shall be screened. The exceptions are:
 - (a) Retail merchandise being displayed in front of the structure;
 - (b) Materials and equipment being used for construction on the premises; and
 - c) Merchandise located on service station pump islands.

153.05 (D)(3) will read as follows:

(D) Landscaping.

(3) Firewood shall be located behind the principal structure, no closer than eight (8) feet from property lines, buildings, and in a single pile no larger than four (4) feet in height, sixteen (16) feet long, and eight (8) feet wide.

All other provisions of Chisholm City Code 153.04 and 153.05 shall remain as currently in existence and not amended except as specifically added herein and said amendment shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
